The Missoula dispatch said: "A rush telegram was received in Missoula this afternoon at the county clerk and recorder's office which told a chapter in a story that would be interesting if it were all told. The message was dated at Kalispell and read as follows: "Have Billy Lewis and Jennie Morant taken out a marriage license? Answer quick. Margaret Morant." "The answer to the hasty inquiry was sent in the negative, as Mr. Billy and Jennie had been seen at the Missoula court house up to that time. They must have gone elsewhere, or else are on their way here and will arrive later. No one at the court house knew any of the parties, but the inference, as the independent would say, is that there is a runaway couple on the road somewhere that Margaret Morant would like to locate." This afternoon "Billy and Jennie" walked into the court house in Great Falls and applied to Deputy Clerk Lockhart for a marriage license. The man gave his name as William Lewis, of Kalispell, aged 43, and the would-be bride answered to the name of Jennie Morant and gave her age as 15 years. The license was issued and at 5 o'clock this evening the couple proceeded to the office of Judge Horrocks and were united in marriage. They refuse to discuss their history and would not say where they were liberating since Oct. 15. The bride is a charmingly handsome young woman and is barely 15 years of age.—Great Falls Oct.
