The State of Montana sends greetings
to the above named defendants
and to each of them:

You are hereby summoned to answer the complaint in this action, which is filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court, a copy of which is herewith served upon one of you in each county wherein any of you reside, and to file your answer and serve a copy thereof upon the Plaintiff's attorney within twenty days after the service of this Summons, exclusive of the day of service; and in case of your failure to appear or answer, judgment will be taken against you, by default, for the relief demanded in the complaint. This action is brought for the purpose of securing a divorce by plaintiff from the defendant and dissolving the bonds of matrimony between the plaintiff and defendant. It is alleged in the complaint that the defendant has for more than one year before the filing of the complaint, to-wit: since about the 23rd day of December, 1919, willfully and without cause deserted and abandoned the plaintiff and ever since has and still continues to go willfully and without cause desert and abandon the plaintiff and to live separate and apart from her without any sufficient cause or reason, against her will and without her consent. It is also alleged in the complaint that the defendant, for more than one year last past, to-wit: since about the 23rd day of December, 1919, has willfully neglected to provide plaintiff with the common necessities of life, having the ability so do to.
