BUTTE BOY DROWNED IN MISSOULA COUNTY

Missoula, July 12.—Bert Favero, 22 year old Butte boy, was drowned in Stoney creek in Granite county Saturday evening at a point 45 miles up the canyon from the mouth of Rock creek, according to word received here last night.

Favero, with a camping party from Butte, was fishing near the mouth of Stoney creek. Other members of the party noticed him floundering in the water and went to his rescue. Poles and timbers were thrown to him, but after he had struggled in the water while he was carried a quarter of a mile down the stream he sank from sight. The body was recovered yesterday near the Anderson bridge, some distance down the stream.
