**FRED THERRIAULT DIES  
SUDDENLY IN FLORIDA**

A telegram was received here yesterday stating that Fred Therriault died February 28 at West Palm Beach, Florida, and no particulars were given. It was not known that he was in anything but the best of health. In a letter written by him very recently no mention is made of any illness, so friends here assume that death must have come very unexpectedly of natural causes, or that he met with a violent death.

Mr. Therriault was a cousin of Michael and Henry Therriault, old-timers in the Flathead, and himself lived here for a period of years before going to Florida about 12 years ago.

In Florida he did well, but on account of the ill health of Mrs. Therriault returned to the Flathead last summer making his home on an 80-acre ranch which he purchased at Creston. Mrs. Therriault passed away at the ranch home on December 18, last, and Mr. Therriault shortly thereafter returned to Florida to adjust his financial affairs there, incident to the collapse of the Florida boom, to return to the Flathead next May.

He was born in northern Maine 66 years ago, and is survived by three daughters and five sons, all of whom reside in Washington and Oregon.

**JOHN TOOLE OF MISSOULA  
DIES IN AUTO ACCIDENT**

Butte, Mont., June 3.—John Toole, youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. John R. Toole of Missoula, was killed in an accident near Ventura, California, May 28, according to word received here. Details of the accident have not been received but it is said that Toole, who was engaged in the bond business at Los Angeles, boarded an auto bus for San Francisco and was killed while on that trip. He was accompanied by his business partner.

He was 27 years of age, having been born in Anaconda in 1900. He came to Missoula with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John R. Toole, in 1903, and attended the Missoula grade schools.

Mr. Toole was best man at the wedding of Wallace Lebkicher and Miss Anne Ross, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David Ross, here last fall. Mr. Ross said that from a letter from his daughter just previous to the accident he understood that Toole had made arrangements to enter business with Mr. Lebkicher at Wilmington, California.
