Unwin, their foster son, died July 22 at Brishane hospital in Australia. The firred cause of death was intra corebral hemoir-rhage received through an accident. "Eddie" Unwin, as he was familiar-"Eddle" Unwin, as he was fantilar-ly known, was 21 years of age and a graduate of Flathead county high school with the class of 1939, and was a member of the football feam.
