SGT. EDWIN W. UNWIN DIES IN BRISBANE, AUSTRALIA HOSPITAL
Mr. and Mrs. Gerrit Van Rinsum of Somers have received word from the war department that Sergeant Edward W. Unwin, their foster son, died July 22 at Brisbane hospital in Australia. The direct cause of death was intra cerebral hemorrhage received through an accident. "Eddie" Unwin, as he was familiarly known, was 21 years of age and a graduate of Flathead county high school with the class of 1939, and was a member of the football team. He joined the National Guard in January 1939 and left with the contingent about two years ago although he was here a number of times on furlough. His family has the sympathy of his many friends both in Kalspell and Somers.
