ACTION ON IWO JIMA**
Charles G. Fischer of the United
States Marine Corps, was killed in
action on Iwo Jima on February
23, according to information re-
ceived from the War department
by his father, Gilbert Fischer of
Somers.
The message states that the Ma-
rine was killed in the performance
of his duty and in service of his
country. Depest sympathy is ex-
pressed by A. A. Vandergriff, com-
mandant of the Marine corps.
Fischer was born and raised in
Somers and graduated from Flat-
head county high school in 1942. He
entered the service in November,
1942, and went overseas in March,
1943. He was a veteran of Bougain-
ville, Guadalcanal, New Hebrides
and Ounm. At the time of his death
he was 29 years old.
