YOU ARE HEREBY SUMMONED to answer the Complaint in this action, which is filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court, a copy of which is herewith served upon you in the County wherein you reside and to file your answer and serve a copy thereof upon the Plaintiff's attorney within twenty days after the service of this summons, exclusive of the day of service; and in case of your failure to appear or answer judgment will be taken against you, by default, for the relief demanded in the Complaint in which plaintiff demands judgement and decree of absolute divorce from you, upon the ground of previous mental cruelty, alleging that Plaintiff and defendant were married each unto the other at Seattle, Washington, April 25th, 1945, that plaintiff is and for more than one year last past has been a resident of Montana; that there are no children the issue of said marriage; that defendant is of an extremely jealous, suspicious and critical disposition and frequently without cause or justification has accused plaintiff of improper conduct with other women; that defendant frequently during the first year of marriage took funds belonging to plaintiff and without notice absented herself from their home for long

periods of time without informing plaintiff where she was or what she was doing which conduct she continued for more than one year; that plaintiff several times condoned such action of defendant but she continued to so treat plaintiff; that defendant has twice commenced actions for divorce from plaintiff falsely accusing him of cruelty toward her and has not carried either such actions to a conclusion, but nevertheless falsely that plaintiff was and had been cruel toward her.
