### Laurel Man Awarded Bronze Star

BILLINGS (AP) — Volunteering to rescue wounded men by going under enemy fire and doing it again and again has earned a Bronze Star for Army Spec. 5 Dennis Allwin of Laurel. Allwin is an infantryman with the Fourth Battalion of the 25th Infantry Division's 9th Infantry. The medal presented Sept. 10 in Vietnam, was earned while engaged in ground operations in Vietnam. The citation says that Allwin volunteered to rescue wounded soldiers and again and again braved intense enemy fire while evacuating wounded comrades. His actions last June 6 were credited with saving several lives and allowing the successful completion of the mission. He is the 21-year-old son of Mrs. John Allwin of Laurel.
