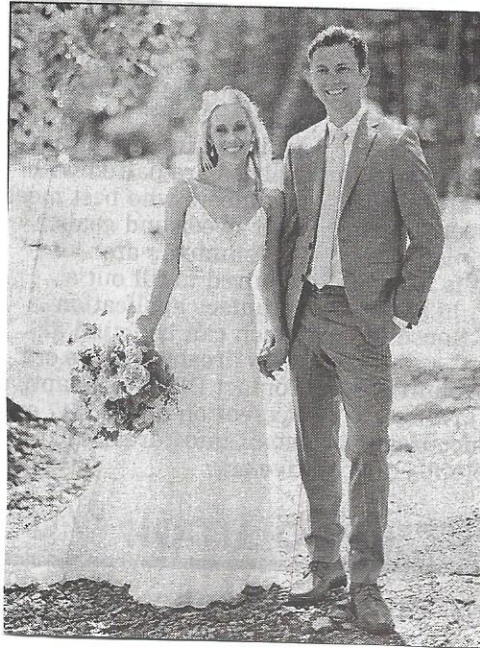

Groomsmen were Taylor Streit, Carl Nystuen, Jonathan Iblings and Andrew Helder.

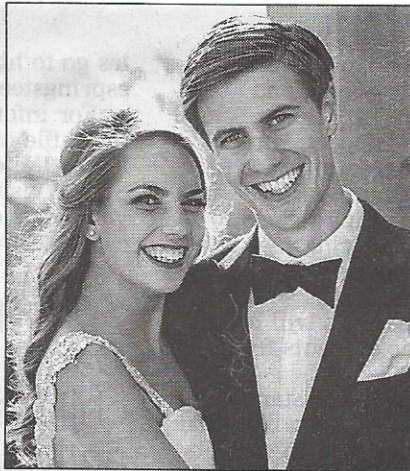

Best man was Matthew Cope of Kalispell. Groomsman was Wrango West of Kalispell.

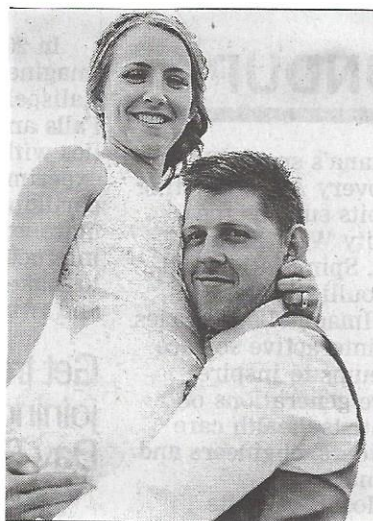
Ushers were niece Reece Pitcher and nephew Erikson Pitcher, both of Philipsburg.

Maid of honor was Mikayla Wisner of Kalispell.

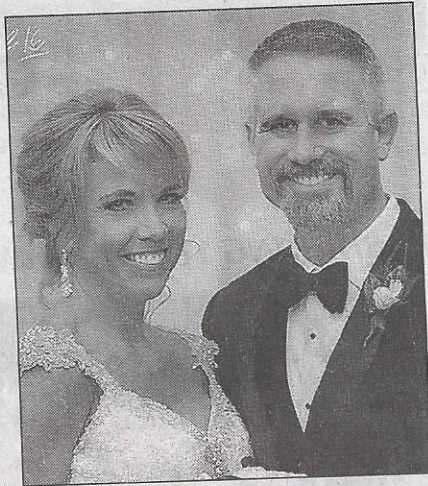

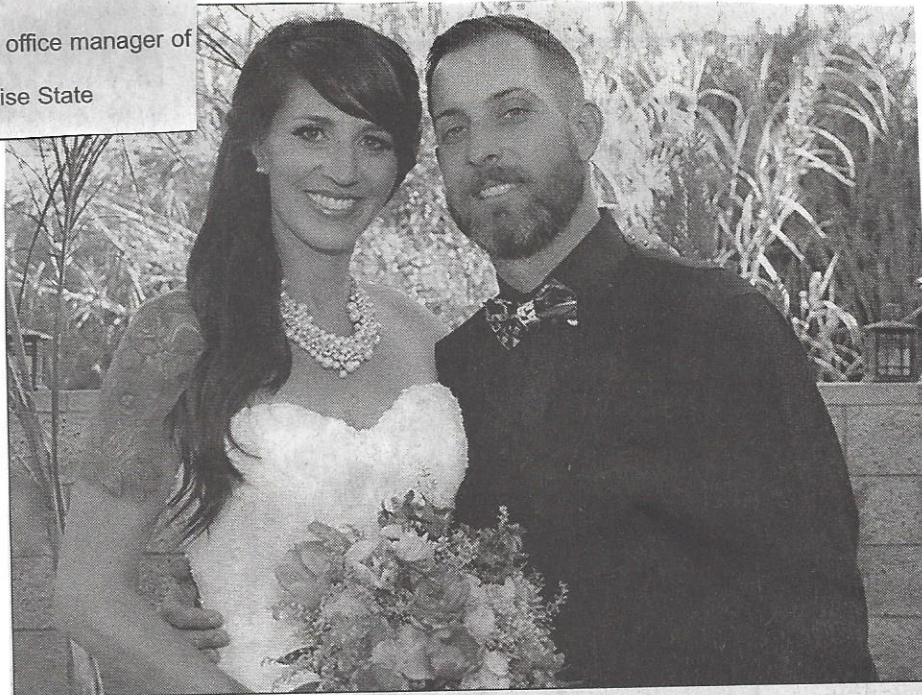

The bridegroom is the son of Nancy Thibo and Adrian Hoye of Missoula, and the late Thomas D. Gale.

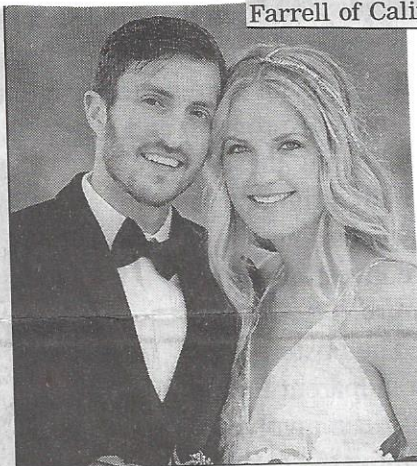

Melissa Shea and Hank Haarmann were married March 18 at Catamaran Bay in San Diego.

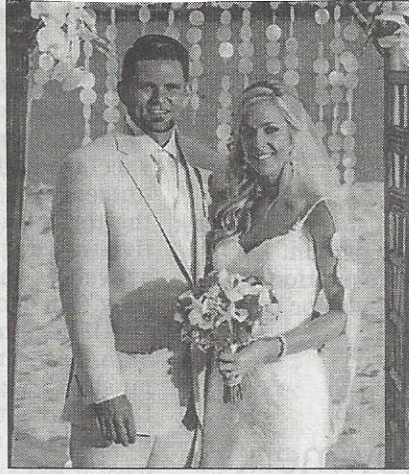

Barbara Fopp and Harold Paullin

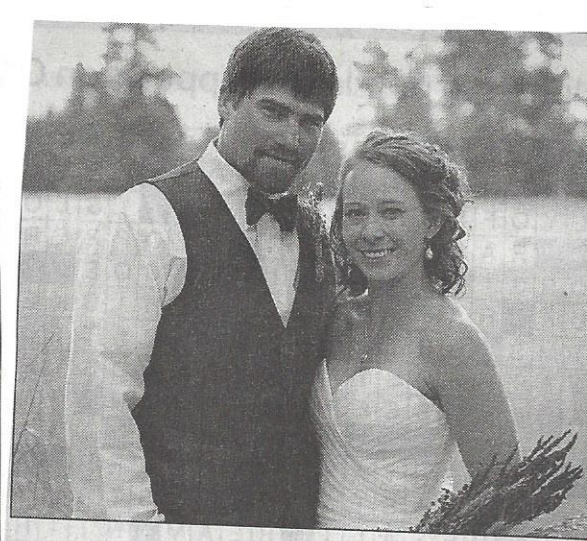

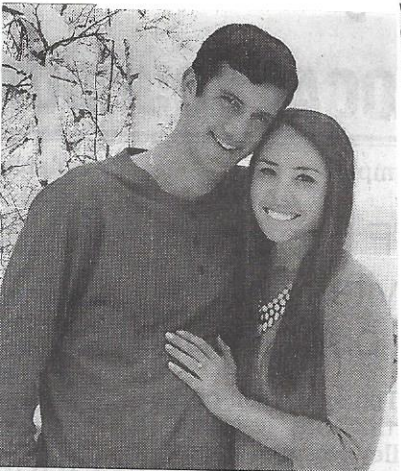

The bridegroom is the son of the late Jim and Laverne Willows.

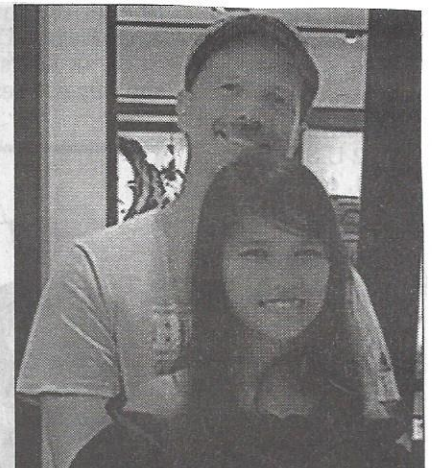
