C. E. UFFORD DEAD

The death of C. E. Ufford, who has been ill for the past three years, occurred at 8:30 Saturday evening.

Mr. Ufford, who was 53 years of age, suffered a stroke of paralysis three years ago, since which time he has been in very poor health. Another stroke occurred Saturday, which he was unable to survive.

Beside his son, C. A. Ufford, he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. G. W. Case of Eugene, Oregon and Mrs. H. K. Deltz of Mason City, Iowa. Mrs. Case and Mrs. Deltz were communicated to by wire, but will be unable to attend the funeral, which will be held at 2 o'clock Wednesday at the Shuman and Miller chapel, Rev. M. - M. Fisher officiating. Burial will be made in Conrad cemetery.

The deceased made his home during recent years with his son, C. A. Ufford of this city.
