Obituary

Knud Iverson was born in Gol, Halingdahl, Norway, January 9, 1850. He migrated to the United States with his parents at the age of 15, and when he was 21 he settled on a homestead in the Red River valley, near Fargo, North Dakota, where he was engaged in farming until 1910, when he moved to Kallspell. He continued to farm, living northwest of town.
