

# ST. IGNATIUS MAN KILLED IN CRASH; WIFE NEAR DEATH

Polson, Oct. 2.—Injured in a head-on highway crash four miles south of here last night, E. E. Udall, being near St. Ignatius, died in the hospital here today.

Mrs. Udall, victim of the same crash, was given little chance to recover, physicians said.

Donald Hutton, riding with the Udalls, had a broken shoulder and other injuries but was expected to live.

Melvin Udall, son of the dead man, and driver of a truck which crashed into his parents' car, escaped with a broken shoulder and severe bruises.

The younger Udall, driver for a Polson firm, was enroute to his father's home when he swerved to one side of the road to permit another truck to pass, and in so doing hit his father's machine.
