**G. N. TRACK WALKER  
KILLED BY TRAIN**

John Zagotta, 52, a trackwalker in the employ of the Great Northern Railroad, was killed near Vista at about 11:30 this morning, when the speeder on which he was riding was struck by a local freight train.

Coroner Campbell was called to investigate, and learned that Zagotta, who was alone, was trying to remove the speeder from the track when the train came around a curve and struck him. An attempt was made to get him to Whitefish for medical aid, but he died on the way. His skull was fractured, which it is believed caused his death, although there may have been other injuries.

He is survived by his wife and four or five children at Whitefish.
