PASSES AWAY IN
PORTLAND, ORE.**

Word of the death of W. B. MacDonald at a Portland hospital shortly after midnight last night was received here today.

The news was contained in a message from Mrs. MacDonald to Mayor Bruckhauser.

Mr. MacDonald had been in failing health for several years, and a number of months ago left for Portland for medical treatment, but never recovered sufficiently to be able to return home.

He has for many years been manager of the Mountain States Power company, and was one of the most highly respected and esteemed citizens of KallsPELL.

Mrs. MacDonald's message stated that she was leaving for KallsPELL Wednesday, but no funeral arrangements have been made as yet.
