Word was received here at noon today that Marius Anderson, well known Kalispell man, passed away this morning at Seattle.

Mr. Anderson had been in ill health for a number of years, and left several months ago for the coast in the hope that he would be benefited by the lower altitude.

When Mr. Anderson came here from eastern Montana in 1920 he built the Liberty theater, which he, his son, Carl Anderson, and R. D. McDaniels operated for a number of years. Failing health caused him to retire from active business, and his interest was taken over by his son.

His sons Sophus and Melvin Anderson and daughter, Mrs. Arthur Birch, left today for Seattle by automobile to be with Mrs. Anderson. The body is being shipped to Kalispell, and will be met by Carl Anderson at Whitefish when it arrived on train 2 Monday. Funeral arrangements have not been completed, and will be announced later.
