AGAINST THE ESTATE  
OF JOHN E. LEWIS**

Five suits against Nettie C. Lewis, administratrix of the estate of J. E. Lewis, deceased, have been brought by Mable Murphy, Kathryn Miller, Monica Correll, Mary Matthews, and H. A. Kendall, representing Hazel Steger, an incompetent, all of whom claim an interest in the J. E. Lewis estate.

Lewis died December 7, 1934 without children, and therefore without "heirs" as the word was intended to be construed in the conveyance. They state that claims for \$2,000 each were presented to Nettie C. Lewis, the administratrix of the estate, November 16, 1935, but were rejected, and they are therefore asking judgment in this amount.
