PERRY JOHNSON FATALLY INJURED BY FALLING TREE

Perry A. Johnson, aged 46, died yesterday at a local hospital from injuries sustained when he was struck by a falling tree at the Kinshella logging camp near Olney. He suffered severe head injuries and fractures of the left leg and arm. He died shortly after he was brought to the hospital.

Although no details of the accident could be learned, it is understood that he had been logging for the Kinshellas for about three months. Johnson came here with his family from Canada several months ago. He was born in Iowa. He is survived by his widow and four children.

This is the third fatal accident to occur at the Kinshella camp within the past two years.
