Mrs. Christiana Nunn passed away at her home in Kalspell yesterday morning at the age of 86 years, following several days' illness.

Mrs. Nunn was one of the pioneer settlers of Montana, having come to Marysville, near Helena in 1881. She came to the Flathead in 1888 with her husband, Joseph Nunn, and they settled on a farm in the Montford district. They moved into Kalspell some 30 years ago.

Mrs. Nunn is survived by her husband and one daughter, Mrs. Bertha Henderson of Warrick, Montana. Also a number of grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at the Kalspell Funeral Home chapel tomorrow afternoon at 1 o'clock with Rev. Walter H. Sandy officiating. The body will be taken on Train No. 2 to Big Sandy, where a funeral service will be held Wednesday, followed by interment there.
