CRASH HURTS FATAL TO JOHN EDWARDS

John Edwards, 57, succumbed last evening to injuries he received in an automobile accident which occurred about 10:30 a. m. eight miles north of Kallispell.

Edwards was a chimney sweep by trade and has been working around Kallispell and Whitefish for the past year. It is believed that his home is at Virginia, Minnesota, although as yet officers here have been unable to contact relatives.

His injuries were received when the car in which he was riding, allegedly driven by Ray Hayworth of Whitefish, got out of control and crashed into the ditch. Hayworth will be arraigned before Justice Thomas Stacey, of Whitefish on a drunken driving charge.

Edwards' body is at the Waggener & Campbell funeral chapel, pending word from relatives.

John Edwards of Whitefish passed away in Kallispell last evening following injuries received in an automobile accident Friday morning.

The body is at the Waggener & Campbell Funeral home and will be sent to Minnesota for burial.
