GEORGE FESSENDEN DEAD

A telegram from Lawrence Fessenden announced the death of his uncle, George A. Fessenden, at San Diego, Calif., today. Mrs. Fessenden's death occurred on October 12, following an operation for gall stones.

Both were pioneer residents of this county, Mr. Fessenden coming here as surveyor of public lands in the early days, and they remained here to make their home.

Mr. Fessenden at one time operated a steamboat on Flathead lake, and afterward was county surveyor here for several term. They also lived for short periods in Polson and Ronan, where they operated hotels.

About a year ago they left for California because of Mr. Fessenden's ill health. He had made some improvement, but apparently was unable to withstand the shock of her death. Their nephew, Lawrence Fessenden, who has made his home with them since he was a small boy, was with them to the last.

Funeral arrangements have not been completed.
