**SOMERS CHILD IS DROWNING VICTIM**

Heather Milne, aged 2 years, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Allan Milne of Somers, was drowned about 8:45 o'clock this morning when she fell into a cess-pool at the Milne home in Somers.

The tragedy occurred shortly after the tot had gone out to play and was evidently inspecting a screen and some boards thrown across a portion of the cess-pool which had caved in last evening.

Mr. Milne said that one of the top boards covering the pool had rotted through and he had thrown a screen door and some boards across the top as a guard until he was able to repair the covering. The child had crawled onto the screen, which gave way and precipitated her into the pool.

Investigation by Coroner Campbell indicated that she fell head first and was drowned immediately, as there was less than two feet of water in the pool.

Funeral services will be announced later.
