Frank Wilbur Utley was born February 6, 1912, near Libby, and as a small boy moved to Somers. He

spent his childhood at Somers and Kila. In the year 1935 he was married to Miss Elera Livingston at Spokane and they later moved to Fort Bliss, Texas. About 15 months ago they moved to Bend, Oregon, where he entered the employ of the Brooks-Scanlon Lumber company. Mr. Utley was injured October 28, while on duty and died a short time later. He was 26 years of age.
