FORMER RESIDENT OF KALISPELL IS FOUND DEAD IN GREAT FALLS

Information received here yesterday from Great Falls said that Rex Hooley, 40, World war veteran and former Kalspell resident, was found dead about midnight Monday in the washroom of a tavern there.

Although there were bruises on the left side of his face, Great Falls authorities said he evidently died of a heart attack. The bruises were superficial, it was said. His body was found apparently only a few minutes after his death.

Healey was born at Anacanda and had been employed in newspaper work in Chicago, Salt Lake City, Great Falls, Billings and Miles City. While living here he was employed as instructor for foremen in the Works Progress Administration. He served with the marines during the World war and spent some time in a veterans hospital after the war.

He is survived by his widow, Lilian, and a brother, Robert, of Spokane.
