William Irvine of Polson Succumbs

Polson, June 19—William (Billy) Irvine, one of this section's best-known and most highly respected pioneer residents, died here Saturday morning at a local hospital two days after his eighty-third birthday anniversary. He had been in failing health for the past two months.

Mr. Irvine, one of the most picturesque characters in this section, saw Western Montana develop from virgin territory to its present-day advancement. Having spent most of his life as a stockman he could recall many interesting stories of the early west and the cattle drives of those days.
