**David Nadeau, Aged  
Columbia Falls Man,  
Is Burned To Death**

David Nadeau, 84, years of age, was found dead at his home in Columbia Falls this morning from burns and suffocation from a fire which was evidently started from a kerosene lamp which he had knocked off the table during an epileptic fit.

The discovery was made by the milkman who was delivering milk at Nadeau's home.

Nadeau lived alone and was known to have frequent spells of epileptic fits, once previously nearly setting his home on fire in a similar manner. He had lived in Columbia Falls for the past 42 years.

The body was brought to the Waggener & Campbell funeral home and services will be held from the chapel at 10 a. m. Tuesday. Burial will be made in the Demersville cemetery.
