Mr. Parsons was engaged in ranching at Elmo and Polson previous to leaving for California, where he owned a string of race horses, making many of the largest tracks in the United States and Canada, as well as Mexico and Havana, Cuba.

Besides his wife he is survived by a son, Chester, and a daughter, Mrs. Daisy Richards, in California; two brothers, George Parsons of Rollins and J. M. Parsons of Kallispell, and two sisters, Mrs. Lily Reed of Spokane and Mrs. Smith of this city.
