**PIONEER COLUMBIA FALLS
WOMAN DIES IN WASHINGTON**

Word was received here last evening that Mrs. Carrie Valentine had passed away Wednesday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Charles Meekun, at Puyallup, Wash. Mrs. Valentine had celebrated her 55th birthday anniversary on November 16.

Deceased was one of the pioneers of the Flathead valley, having arrived here in 1892 from Iowa, and with her husband homesteaded

what is now known as the Opaku ranch near the mouth of Madrock canyon. She left here 30 years ago.

She is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Flora Baker and Mrs. Minnie Baker, both of Whitefish, and Mrs. Glice Hawkins of Berkeley, Calif., and two sons, Frank and Bert, both of Sacramento. (Montana Review).
