**Frank M. Anderson Found Dead in Bed, Had Taken Own Life**

Frank M. Anderson, 60, a resident of Somers for the past 20 years, was found dead in bed today shortly before noon with a bullet wound in his head and a .22 calibre rifle lying across the bed. Coroner Harry H. Campbell declared it was a clear case of suicide.

The body was discovered by neighbors following an investigation after he failed to go to work this morning at the tie plant, where he was the engineer.

Neighbors asserted that they saw Anderson around his place about 9 o'clock this morning and others stated they heard a shot at the Anderson place sometime during the forenoon, but were unable to give the exact time.

Mr. Anderson is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Virginia Nelson, a resident of North Dakota, and a sister, Mrs. John Herman of Niagara and Kalispell. No reason could be given for Mr. Anderson's act. He left no message.
