Grover Forgey of Wood's Bay Drowns In Flathead Lake

Grover Forgey, 56, of Wood's bay, drowned early last evening near Yenny's point on Flathead lake when the boat in which he and his wife were fishing upset when he slipped while reeling in a fish.

Mrs. Forgey was thrown into the water also, but managed to reach the overturned boat, to which she clung until rescued an hour later by Tony Ronning, who heard her cries for help from his home across the bay.

Forgey's body has not yet been recovered, but Deputy Sheriff DeGollier of Polson and Coroner John Dimon went to the scene of the accident last night and were conducting a search for the body today with the assistance of friends and neighbors.

Mrs. Forgey is under the care of a doctor as she is suffering from shock and exposure. The accident occurred about 5:30 Monday evening and Mrs. Forgey was in the water until about 6:30 o'clock. Mr. Ronning was unable to lift her into his motor boat and was compelled to attach a rope under her arms and tow her to shore.

The Forgeys have no children. Mr. Forgey has been living in this section for about 30 years, coming to Montana from Ohio while still a boy.
