**MRS. VAUGHN, LIBBY,
IS FATALLY BURNED**

Libby, Mont., March 13—(P)—Mrs. Katie Vaughn, 41, was fatally burned when fuel she was using to force a fire exploded, transforming her clothing into a blazing torch.

Friends said Mrs. Vaughn picked up a can which she supposed contained only black oil when she attempted to start the fire yesterday. Apparently there was some gasoline in the can, which exploded, covering her with the flaming fuel.

Her husband was seriously burned about the hands and arms in attempting a rescue. A son finally succeeded in smothering the flames with a blanket.

Survivors include her husband, two sons and a daughter.
