**W. H. Young Dead; Failed to Recover From an Operation**

The many friends of W. H. Young were shocked to hear of his death which occurred yesterday at St. Luke's hospital in Spokane. Very few details are known here at this time, further than that Mr. Young underwent a major operation last Tuesday and it is thought his death resulted from complications following the operation.

The body is being brought to Kalispell for funeral services and burial

which are expected to be held Thursday from the Owen-Elliott Mortuary.

Mr. Young is an old-time resident of Montana, coming from St. Louis, Mo. He has been identified with politics in the Democratic party and attended the national Democratic convention in Chicago as a delegate this year. He has been manager of the state liquor store here since its inauguration several years ago.

Besides his wife, he is survived by one daughter, Lucy, who is teaching in St. Luke's hospital in Spokane. Mrs. Young and Miss Lucy are arriving home this afternoon. Funeral arrangements will be announced later.
