Mrs. Baluski, Auto Accident Victim Saturday, Passes

Mrs. Jacob Baluski, 64, Garrison North Dakota, died Sunday afternoon from injuries received in a car mishap on Highway No. 2 about five miles west of Kalispell Saturday and arrangements have been made to ship the body to Garrison for funeral services.

The accident in which Mrs. Baluski suffered her fatal injuries occurred when the car in which she was riding skidded on a wet stretch of the highway and plunged over the embankment.

Brought to the hospital by a passing motorist, W. F. Arndt of Columbia Falls, Mrs. Baluski was able to walk up the hospital steps by herself, but examination disclosed that she suffered serious internal injuries.

Mr. Baluski also suffered injuries but hospital authorities said he be released today and will accompany the body back to North Dakota.

Riding in the same car with Mr. and Mrs. Baluski were their son, who was driving, and a daughter-in-law and a friend. The car was almost totally demolished.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Baluski is survived by five sons and seven daughters. Owen-Elliott mortuary is in charge of the body.
