Body of Godfrey Johnson is Found

The body of Godfrey Johnson, about 60, woods worker in this vicinity for the past 25 years or more, was found late Saturday afternoon hanging from a tree 500 yards west of Olney.

Coroner Harry H. Campbell said the body had probably been there since the latter part of September, about the time Johnson disappeared after having been released from the Kinshella logging camp. The body was found by Roy Belteber, employe at the logging camp, who with other employes assisted in identifying the body.

Private funeral services were held from the Waggener and Campbell chapel last evening, burial being made in the Demersville cemetery. Johnson had no known relatives.
