### TRUCK - BICYCLE ACCIDENT FATAL TO JEAN MAHUGH

**Eleven-Year-Old Girl Almost Instantly Killed This Noon at First Avenue West and Seventh Street**

Jean Mahugh, 11-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jesse Mahugh, residing about two miles south of KallsPELL, was almost instantly killed about noon today at First avenue west and Seventh street in a collision with a city truck driven by Lawrence Anderson. She never regained consciousness, and died upon reaching the hospital.

Jean had stayed overnight with a friend in KallsPELL, and was evidently starting for her home when the accident occurred. Mr. Anderson stated to the authorities she made a U turn and ran into his truck, not giving him any time to take steps to avert the accident.

County Attorney D. Gordon Rogan and Chief of Police Leif Gausstad immediately started an inquiry, which is not as yet completed, and it is possible that Coroner Harry H. Campbell will hold an inquest tomorrow, if it is deemed necessary.
