**FORMER COL. FALLS CCC YOUTH SHOOTS SELF AT MISSOULA**  
Missoula, June 1—(AP)—Walking into a second-hand store here this morning and asking to look at a target pistol, a former CCC youth slipped a cartridge into the weapon and fired it into his head, Coroner E.La Stucky reported. She said that death was instantaneous.  
The youth, Charles Henry Vogel, 22, of Brownsfield, Pa., and until recently a member of CCC company 368 at Columbia Falls, left a note indicating his intention to take his own life, Mrs. Stucky said.  
R. D. Mercer, proprietor of the store, said that the young man, an employe of a restaurant here, shot himself just as Mercer had turned his back to select another pistol to show to his customer.  
Vogel has a brother in Brownsfield.
