**LIEUT HARRY ENDSLEY
LOSES HIS LIFE IN
AIR MISHAP SUNDAY**

Lieutenant Harry Endsley lost his life in an accident off the Maryland coast Sunday.

This information was contained in a telegram from the War Department to Mrs. Endsley, the former Martha Jennison. Lieut Endsley was a pilot of a bomber, which was on submarine patrol duty, and a telephone message from his commanding officer said the accident occurred when he "bailed out" at 20,000 feet.

Lieutenant Endsley was a recruiting officer at Missoula at one time, but enlisted in the air corps after war was declared. He leaves a little son he has never seen. The baby was born about a month ago.

Word has been received by the Waggener and Campbell funeral home that the body of Lt. Harry Endsley will arrive in Kalispell Saturday afternoon. The funeral arrangements are incomplete and will be announced later.
