E. J. Van Duzer died Friday noon in Portland, Ore., following a stroke, according to information received in Kalispell. He had resided in Kalispell for a great many years, leaving here in May with Mrs. Van Duzer to make his home in Portland.

Mr. Van Duzer was about 61 years old at the time of his death. In the early part of the century he was associated with the Kalispell Mercantile Co. Later, he was with the Conrad National bank, a connection which he had for 32 years.
