**Mercy Trip Fails
To Save Man's Life**

All efforts to save the life of Niles N. Nelson of Whitefish, stricken by an undiagnosed disease, failed and the Great Northern brakeman passed away at the Whitefish hospital this morning.

Instrumental in attempts to save the man's life was Sol Catron of Whitefish who flew in his plane to Missoula Wednesday evening to get a supply of carbogen and an adaptor. State highway patrolmen also brought a portable iron lung by auto from Missoula, but it did not arrive in time to be of sufficient aid.

The call for carbogen was made when the supply offered by the Whitefish fire department dwindled, and it was realized more was needed.

A full study of the man's case will be made but in the meantime the hospital staff has not attempted to name the fatal ailment. His respiratory system was affected, they said. It was first reported he was suffering from tularemia.

Mr. Nelson was 44 years of age and is survived by his wife and children.

**DEATH OF WHITEFISH
MAN MAY BE
SOLVED BY AUTOPSY**

Whitefish, May 3—(P)—An autopsy has been authorized in the death of Niles N. Nelson, to determine, if possible, what caused the paralysis of the lungs which killed him.

Nelson succumbed yesterday, after Whitefish firemen worked on him with a resuscitator for 26 hours, and an iron lung and medical supplies were rushed here from Missoula by plane and automobile.

Physicians were puzzled concerning the death and the federal laboratory at Hamilton was asked to make an analysis to see if the paralysis could have been caused by Rocky Mountain spotted fever.
