**Sophus Olson Dies  
Of Crash Injuries**

Sophus Clarence Olson, 48, of  
Missoula, passed away at the Kalspell  
hospital early Monday morning  
from injuries sustained in a car  
crash on the approach to the bridge  
over the Flathead river on highway  
No. 2 east of Kalspell last Thurs-  
day evening.

Olson suffered a fractured knee,  
dislocated hip and a severe case of  
shock. John A. Hendricks, a ranch-  
er of the Bigfork district, was driver  
of the other car and died almost in-  
stantly. With the death of Olson, an-  
inquest into the death of Hendricks  
has been cancelled by Coroner Harry  
Campbell.

Mr. Olson was a veteran of World  
War I and is survived by his wife  
and two children, living in Missou-  
la. The body is at the Waggener and  
Campbell funeral home and will be  
taken to Missoula for services and  
burial later in the week.
