Harvey Bell Ulrich was born in Fayetteville, Pennsylvania December 13, 1867. He came to Flathead county in 1906 and for a number of years was engineer on the steamboat "Klondike," plying between Somers and Polson. In 1917 he was married to Anne Gillard who survives him. In 1924 he and his wife retired and made their home on the west lakeshore at Rollins since that time.

He leaves to mourn his passing, besides his wife, two sisters, Mrs. Ann Arthur of Great Falls and Mrs. Dan Jeppeson of Milford, Iowa. Three brothers, Harry, of Houston, Texas; Charlie, of Great Falls, and Alva, of Somers, all of whom were here to attend the funeral services. Mr. Ulrich passed at a local hospital Friday evening after a short illness, at the age of 79 years.
