Missing Man's Body Recovered From River
POLSON — The body of Robert J. Elberson, 21, Edwardsville, Ill., has been recovered from the north fork of the Joeko River. Elberson drowned June 25 while trying to ford the river utilizing an improvised rope and wading stick.
Gail Anderson, an employe of the Indian Irrigation Service on the Flathead reservation, spotted Elberson's body lodged amid rocks in the middle of the 30-foot-wide stream. It was about 450 feet downstream from where Elberson had fallen in.
Lake County Sheriff Bill Phillips was notified at 5:30 p.m. Thursday of the discovery. The body was brought ashore and taken to the Pearson Mortuary at St. Ignatius. Elberson was serving the St. Ignatius Christian Church as summer minister.
