# **Lost Hunter Dies Of** Exhaustion In Swan

POLSON (AP) — A Florida hunter died early Saturday of exhaustion and exposure after becoming lost in the Woodward Creek area of the Swan River

drainage. Tassie II. Farmer, 41, of Tallahassee, Fla., was found dead on a logging road Saturday morning after being the object of a night-long search by hunt-ing companions and two members of the Swan Search and Rescue Association.

Farmer was found without his gun, about eight miles from the area he had been hunting. Lake County Sheriff Bill Phillips said the man obviously had panicked and exhausted himself. There was over a foot of snow in the upper elevations of the area. Farmer and his companions

had been hunting in the area and a search for the man was mounted late Friday when he did not return to camp. Farmer's wife was reportedly in the group of hunters.
The body was first taken to

the Goal Creek Ranger Station; and then to Polson. An autopsy performed at the request of the coroner indicated that Farmer had died sometime after 2 a.m.. Saturday,
