Boy Drowns In Swan Lake

SWAN LAKE—David B. Greytak Jr., 30-month-old son of Mr. and Mrs. David Greytak, Wilmington, Del., drowned in Swan Lake about 8 p.m. Monday.

The boy's body was found by his parents floating between the dock of the Birch Glen resort and an anchored boat. Lake County Coroner-Sheriff Bill Phillips says no inquest is planned.

Phillips reported the Greytak family had been out for a drive and had returned to their cottage to prepare dinner. The youngster slipped away unnoticed. The parents became aware of the silence and started looking for the boy and discovered the tragedy.

Phillips speculated the boy had apparently tried to climb into the boat which gave way from the dock against mooring lines enough that the youngster slipped and fell into the lake.

The body was taken to the Waggoner and Campbell Funeral Home in Kalispell where services are pending.

David was born Jan. 28, 1966, in Wilmington and is survived by his parents; a sister Jacqueline, 5½; paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. John J. Greytak of Great Falls and maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. William Harsanyi of Wilmington.
