Body Of Spokane Man Discovered At Apgar

WEST GLACIER — An eighth grade school picnic group from Kalispell on its annual class outing Monday discovered the body of a Spokane man, a suicide victim, in Glacier National Park. The group had started its activities at the Apgar picnic grounds. Several youngsters left the area and started exploring. They came on a parked car on a normally closed park service road and found the body of Larry R. Jones, 29, 39 West 26th Ave., Spokane, inside his car. Glacier National Park authorities were notified. Also working on the coordinated investigation were the resi-

dent agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Flathead County Deputy Coroner Dean Whitesitt. Death was set at sometime Sunday, likely 24 to 30 hours before the discovery of the parked car about noon Monday. Whitesitt said there was no apparent motive for the gunshot wound with a pistol. Jones was single. He had been attending Gonzaga University law school earlier this year. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred O. Jones, Spokane.
