# Logger Killed By Falling Snag

LIBBY — Joe LaFountain, 54, Bonners Ferry, Idaho, was killed in a woods accident about 11:30 a.m. Monday while working for the Mattison Logging Co. He was killed while falling timber. Lincoln County Coroner

Hal Gompf said LaFountain was struck across the back and pinned to the ground by a dead snag. Apparently green timber hit the snag and dislodged it. LaFountain's body was found by a dozer operator skidding out logs. He saw smoke and

heard a chain saw still running at high speed. Checking it out he discovered the accident. Gompf and Lincoln County Sheriff John Fisher were called to the scene.

The accident occurred on the Stanley Creek road off the Bull Lake highway about 31 miles from Libby. LaFountain was working near a log landing about five miles up the logging road. He is survived by his widow at the family home, four stepchildren and his mother at Bonners Ferry.

Gompf said an inquest will not be necessary. It is the first woods death in Lincoln County this year.

## Man Found Drowned

The body of a 70-year-old Kalispell resident, Fred Leer, was found this morning at the head of Second Avenue West just south of the Great Northern Railway tracks in Kalispell.

Leer was an apparent accidental drowning victim. The body was spotted shortly after 8 a.m. by Bert Strack who was hooking up a tractor to a semi-trailer unit. It was laying almost in the middle of a 30 by 60 foot surface water pond six inches deep in the middle. Coroner-sheriff Ross Wilson conducted the investigation with Kalispell police and County Atty. James Olesen.

Leer's watch was stopped at 3 a.m. indicating time of death. The speculation was Leer had left his home, 77 Fourth Ave. W. N. heading for downtown Kalispell and had taken a short cut across the tracks. There was indication he possibly stumbled and fell, striking his head which knocked him unconscious in the shallow pond where he drowned.
