Man Dies From Gunshot Wound

PROCTOR — Louis Parker, 40, Proctor, died early this morning undergoing emergency surgery at the Kalispell General Hospital for an abdominal gunshot wound.

Parker was shot about 10:45 p.m. Monday with a .22 caliber rifle in the hands of his 14-year-old son at the family home about a quarter mile southwest of Proctor. First taken to St. Joseph's Hospital at Polson for

emergency treatment, he was transferred to the Kalispell hospital for surgery.

Lake County Sheriff Bill Phillips has withheld name of the boy pending completion of investigation of the shooting by his office, County Atty. Cal Christian, and John Corbett, Indian Service law enforcement chief.

Phillips has established there was an altercation between Parker and wife, Mary Lou, and blows were exchanged.

Phillips said, "Apparently the boy, oldest of five children at the Parker home, feared for the safety of his mother. He went for the rifle and fired a single shot at his father which hit him in the abdomen. It proved fatal."

"The boy is now under the authority of Flathead Indian Agency juvenile authorities. We are checking further into the incident questioning Mrs. Parker and other children in the family," Phillips said.

Hikers Find Olney Man's Body In Parked Auto

OLNEY — Two young hikers Sunday found the body of Clyde Parks, 52, Olney, an apparent suicide victim in his parked car three miles off Highway 93 on the Doug Mountain Lookout road. The hikers reported the in-

cident at 6:20 p.m. to Olney residents who called the Flathead County Sheriff's Department and deputy county coroner Dean Whibesitt. Authorities set the time of death as sometime Friday afternoon or evening. Cause of death was a single shot from a .45 caliber pistol.

Funeral arrangements are pending from the Waggener and Campbell Chapel. Parks is known to be survived by a sister, Mrs. Edna Strain, Hansen, Idaho. In checking back on his movements, officers determined that Parks was last seen alive in the downtown Kalispell area early Friday afternoon.
