Charles Runyan, Libby Logging Contractor, Killed In Accident

LIBBY - With the death of Charles R. Runyan, 41, Libby logging contractor, Wednesday afternoon, Northwest Montana has recorded its first traffic fatality of the year.

Runyan was found pinned in the wreckage of his pickup truck after it had run off the road and smashed head on into a large tree on the Upper Ford section of the Yaak River road, 50 miles northwest of Libby. His

chest was crushed by the steering wheel and he had other multiple injuries. Coroner Hal Gompf is not planning an inquest.

First report of the accident reached Montana Highway Patrolman Bernard K. Barton at 12:30 p.m. Barton believed that it had occurred shortly before it was discovered by a nearby resident who was to have met Runyan at noon to check over a logging site.

He found the skid marks on the roadway that led to the demolished truck. Barton says there is no physical evidence to indicate the cause of the fatal crash, and there were no witnesses. Runyan was alone.

Local drivers had put together 112 consecutive days of driving without a fatal accident in the tri-county area.
