Mrs. Alice J. Zimmerman, 68, died in Kalispell Wednesday evening.

Mrs. Zimmerman was born Oct. 24, 1900, near Bigfork, the daughter of William and Mira Marie Johnson. She attended school and grew to womanhood in the Swan Lake area.
