Two Die In Lake County Accident

RONAN - Lake County sheriffs are calling an inquest into the accident at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday six miles south of Ronan on U.S. 93 which resulted in the death of two persons. Michael Bisson, 16, Chaska, was killed outright in the investigation leading to the two-vehicle crash.
